Acceptance:

All entries will be subject to selection. Artists will be notified by phone or email whether they have been selected or not for the exhibition. Selectors decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Presentation:

2D must be presented ready for display e.g matted and/or framed where appropriate. Cords and D-rings or cleats supplied etc. The gallery can supply plinths for 3D work.
