Call for entries for the Wairarapa exhibition 'Under Pressure' to be held at Aratoi – Wairarapa Museum of Art and History on the 22 February 2020. Submissions can include any of these mediums: Etching, linocut, woodcut, screen print, collagraph, lithography, intaglio, relief printing. Artists must be living in the Wairarapa region and can submit up to three pieces of recent work.

We have four non-monetary award categories, but your work can be stand-alone. The categories are:

- Most technical
- Most experimental
- Best mood and atmosphere
- Peoples choice as voted by the public.

Submissions due: Friday 14th February 2020

Where: Masterton Art Club, 12 Victoria Street, Masterton.

Time: Between 9–4pm

Cost: \$10 per artist (you may submit up to 3 works)

Works will be chosen for the exhibition by our selector, local print maker – Liz Bondy. Artists will be notified the following week. For this, please include either an email address or phone number on your entry art label.
